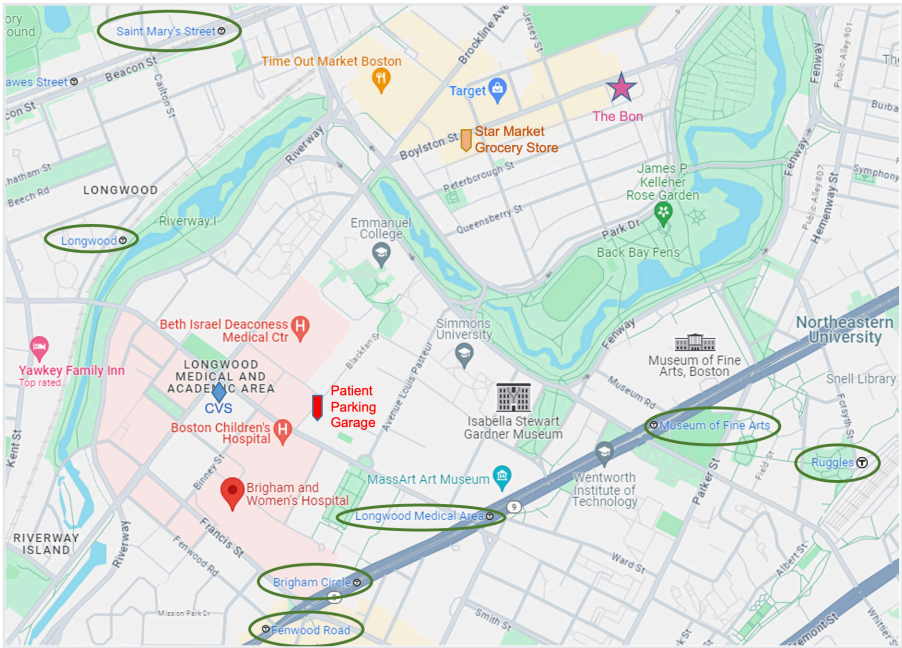

Where to stay in Boston

Wherever you choose to stay during your time in Boston, keep in mind that advanced planning is strongly recommended.

Your best option will depend on your financial resources, the number of people traveling with you, your anticipated length of stay, and your own need for company vs. privacy.

Inpatient stays

All our intensive care units (MSICU, CICU, and NICU) have a space for one parent to sleep at their child's bedside. The ICU can be a challenging place to get a good night's sleep, but this is an option for you to stay close to your baby. We suggest using a white noise machine, noise-canceling headphones, or other sleep comforts to support your rest and recovery should you choose this option.

Boston Children's Hospital Patient Family Housing Program

The [Patient Family Housing Program](#) (PFH) provides affordable accommodations to any parent, guardian, or family member of a Boston Children's Hospital patient who lives beyond 50 miles from the hospital. PFH offers free, on-demand shuttle transportation to and from the hospital. There are two options under this umbrella: Yawkey Family Inn and The Bon by Morro.

Hospitality Homes matches patients and their families who live more than 50 miles from the hospital with housing during their care in Boston. They have a network of host homes with local families as well as some hotel rooms and private apartments. They offer a range of housing options and, as such, their cost varies (typically around \$25-120/ night). They may have some lower-cost options on an as-needed basis.

The Ronald McDonald House at Boston Harbor is a donation-based option for families living more than 50 miles from the hospital. Your stay cannot start sooner than one week before your due date, and they usually have a waitlist. If you are interested in staying here, you can ask a social worker to apply on your behalf.

The Live4Evan Organization offers six fully furnished apartments reserved for families whose children are receiving cardiac care and traveling from more than 50 miles away. They cost \$40 a night with a \$200 deposit. The apartments are located adjacent to Boston Children's Hospital in the Longwood Galleria Apartment building. The maximum occupancy for each apartment is four people.

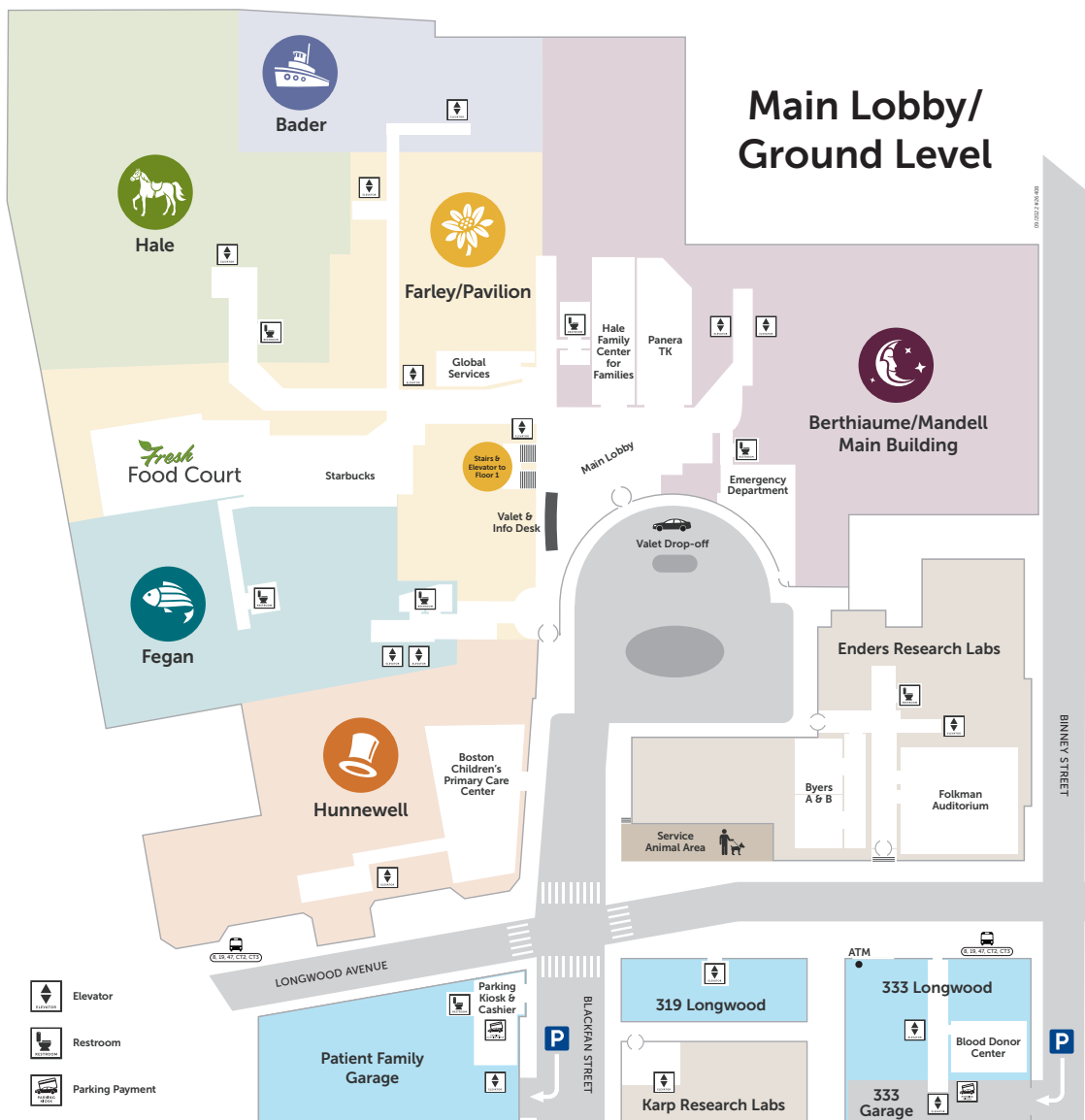
